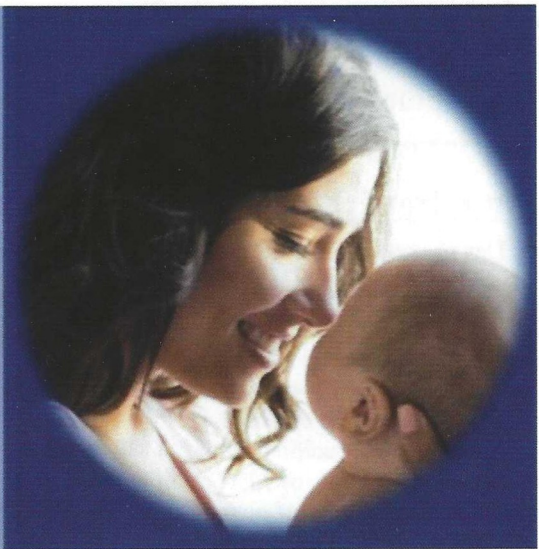

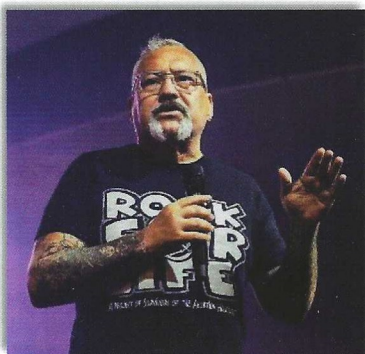

Info from the Ohio Department of Health 2025 Induced Abortion Summary

(Ohio Department of Health Annual and Monthly Abortion Reports are available on line at [ODH Abortion Reports Portal](#).)

1. A total of 25,135 induced pregnancy terminations were reported, including 19,892 obtained by Ohio resident women (79.1%). This represents a 15% increase in induced pregnancy terminations from 2024 to 2025, primarily due to telehealth prescriptions provided to Ohio residents
2. Approximately 32.8% of women were 18 to 24 years old, 69.6% of women were never married, divorced, or widowed. Of all resident women who obtained abortions and race was reported, approximately 48.9% were Black, 42.3% were White, and 3.6% were Asian/Pacific Islander; 4.8% reported more than one race
3. Nearly three quarters, or 73%, of all induced abortions in 2025 involved pregnancies of less than nine weeks, with 17.9% involving pregnancies of nine to 12 weeks (Table 1). There were 293 abortions in 2025 involving pregnancies of 20 or more completed weeks of gestation (Table 1). The abortion reporting form requests methods used to determine gestational age; ultrasound was used in 72.1% of cases (Table 17). Most reported abortions were obtained in six major metropolitan areas of Ohio or via telehealth prescription provided to Ohio residents
4. Curettage (surgical) method was used in 34.7% of terminations in 2025. That method has decreased since 2001, when 87% of terminations were by curettage. There were 14,866 (59.1%) nonsurgical abortions, followed by 2,668 terminations using Misoprostol and 20 terminations using Methotrexate

FAQ

- **Isn't Ohio a pro-life state?** Since Issue 1 passed in 2023, abortion is now legal up to 21 weeks and 6 days of pregnancy.
- **Can't I just pray from my home?** Your prayerful presence can save lives! The **"no-show" rate for abortion appointments goes as high as 75% when people are peacefully praying outside the abortion facility!** *Women have said they were looking for a "sign from God" and you just might be that sign.*
- **Is it safe to pray outside Planned Parenthood? Is it too late to make a difference?** It has been safe since 2007 when 40DFL began this campaign. It is never too late! God uses our prayers no matter the situation.
- **Do I have to make contact with those going in or out of Planned Parenthood?** No, the focus is to be in front of Planned Parenthood as a prayerful witness. However, training opportunities on how to engage those entering or leaving the abortion facility in a compassionate loving way are available.
- **Can I bring a friend?** YES! Invite your family, friends, church, organization or neighborhood! Offer to pray with anyone who is new to praying on the sidewalk.
- **I feel unqualified.** Then you are PERFECT for the mission. God has qualified you and placed within you the desire to be a blessing to babies, moms, dads and those working in this abortion facility.
